

JSSSEE LaTeX Author Guide

How to Use the Template in Overleaf

- 1. Download the official JSSSEE Author Package (ZIP) from the link below.**
 - <https://jsssee.org/JSSSEE-LaTeX.zip>It includes: JSSSEE_Main.tex, JSSSEE-LOGO.PNG, and Figure_Example.png.
- 2. Go to <https://www.overleaf.com>** → New Project → Upload Project → select the ZIP file.
Overleaf will extract all files automatically.
- 3. Open JSSSEE_Main.tex and edit:**
 - \title{ Your Paper Title }
 - \author{ List of authors, affiliations, and emails }
 - Corresponding author section at the top of the document.
- 4. Replace the sample text, tables, and figures with your own content.**
Upload additional figures if needed (File → Upload).
- 5. Compile the project using pdfLaTeX or XeLaTeX.**
Ensure the logo appears, the header/footer display correctly,
and the footer reads 'Open Access, Peer Reviewed eISSN: XXXX-XXXX'.
- 6. Check the final PDF carefully:**
 - Abstract (200–250 words), Keywords (4–6)
 - APA 7th style references
 - Figures and tables numbered and cited in text
- 7. Submit both the final PDF and .tex file via the JSSSEE submission portal.**
